



## **Michigan Angus Auxiliary**

### **2022 Advanced Education Scholarship Application**

To assist more Michigan Junior Angus members with their college education the Michigan Angus Auxiliary is offering two scholarships to upcoming college sophomores, juniors, or seniors. We will award up to two \$500 scholarships, at the discretion of the scholarship committee and judges.

To be considered for this award, all the following rules must be met:

1. Applicants must have been members of the Michigan Junior Angus Association (MJAA) and the National Junior Angus Association (NJAA) for at least 3 years.
2. Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA (accumulative) on a 4.0 scale to be eligible.
3. The applicant cannot have reached their 25<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to January 1 of the year of application.
4. Only use the space provided in each section.

#### **Required Attachments:**

- **Submit an official copy of most recent college transcript.**
- **Submit completed scholarship application.**

These scholarships are not automatically renewed with the Michigan Angus Auxiliary, but a junior member may re-apply. Junior members can receive this scholarship award no more than two times. If selected to receive a scholarship, winners must show proof of being a college, university, technical or trade school student in your second, third, or fourth year by submitting a schedule and receipt showing payment of fees by September 1st.

#### **APPLICATION DEADLINE June 1, 2022**

**Late applications will be refused.** If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, applications must still be emailed by the deadline.
